## Arewa24 ringtones free

Apple's iPhone comes with a healthy selection of ringtones that you can use to customize your mobile experience. You can set up a variety of global ringtones or opt to go with different ringtones for individual people, different groups of friends, and more. (Credit Image: Apple) But what if you want to go a little further and convert one of your favorite songs into a ringtone you can use on your iPhone? Of course, there are several free ringtone applications in nature that give you the opportunity to quickly create new ringtones. But in many cases, applications are not available with all the features you would expect to make creating a ringtone quick and easy. And in some cases, you also need to spend a few dollars just to have the option to choose the section of a song you want. So, if you're serious about making a ringtone, there's a better way. It only takes some time and several steps to make it happen.

Read on to learn how to make ringtones for your iPhone:1. Open iTunes on your desktop to get started.2. Choose the song that you want to use to create a ringtone and click it.3. Right-click the song and choose the Song Info option.4. Click the Options tab.5. Choose up to a 30-second period in the song that your ringtone would like you to do. Apple limits the ringtone to 30 seconds, so you won't be able to have something longer. When selecting time, be sure to enter time in minutes and seconds. Then, if you want to start the ringtone at 1 minute 34 seconds, enter 1:34 in the starting field. Then set it to end 30 seconds later at 2:04. After selecting your schedules, be sure to play it to make sure it's the song piece you really want.6. Click OK.7. With the song highlighted, click &gt; Convert and choose the Create AAC version option. Apple's iTunes will immediately convert the 30-second audio clip that you just chose to create.8. Right-click the ringtone you just created and a Mac, choose the Show option in finder. On a Windows PC, search for the song in the Windows Explorer pane to find its location on your hard disk.9. Change the song file extension from .m4a to .m4r. That's because Apple uses an .m4r extension for ringtones instead of the familiar .m4a. When prompted to keep .m4a or go with .m4r, choose the latter.10. Keep the window open and connect your iPhone to the computer. You'll see the pop-up iPhone in the left sidebar of the screen.11. Drag and drop the .m4r ringtone you just created on the option in the left sidebar, under your iPhone, which says Toni. It should then be seen under the ringtone section in your iPhone.12. Go your iPhone and click Settings.13. Under Settings, choose Sounds and Apts.14. Scroll down to Ringtone and tap the option.15. Here, you should see the ringtone. Select. The ringtone should also play, so you can be sure that it worked properly and everything is good to go. Credit: Tom's Guide By David Weedmark Using the song editing feature in iTunes, you can any song in a personal ringtone for your iPhone. All you have to do is make a copy of your favorite track and then edit it a little to make it in a ringtone that your iPhone can use. Ringtones must be 30 seconds or less, so you'll have to choose which part of the song you want to use. Start iTunes. If prompted, sign in using the same Apple ID and password you use for your iPhone. Drag a music file to the iTunes Music library or press Ctrl-O to import it. Locate the song in the Music library or playlist. Right-click the file name and select Get Information. Click the Options tab in the window that opens. Click the check boxes next to the start time and stop time of the song, and change the times so that the song is 30 seconds or shorter. If you want to start the song one minute later, change the start time to 1:00 am and the stop time to 1:30 a.m. Click OK. Right-click the song again. This time, select Create AAC version to create an AAC copy of the song. If you don't see this option, you need to change your iTunes preferences (see next step). A duplicate 30-second version of the song appears in the Music library below the original. If you don't have the ability to create an AAC version of a song, press Ctrl-B to display the iTunes menu bar. Then select Preferences from the Edit menu and click the Import Settings button on the General tab. Click the Import Using menu and select AAC Encoder. Click OK twice to close the Preferences windows. Right-click the original song file, the one that still shows the full time interval, and select Get Information again. Highlight and delete the start time and stop time, and then click OK. This way the original song file comes to its normal length. Open Windows Control Panel, select Appearance and Customization, and then click Folder Options. Click the View tab, and then clear the check box next to Hide extensions for known file types. You need to be able to see the song file extension to make it a ringtone file. Right-click the 30-second AAC version of the song in iTunes and select Open in Windows Explorer. Right-click the file in Windows Explorer and select Rename. Highlight the extension .mp3 and replace it with the .m4r file extension used for ringtones. Press Enter. Click the menu button in the upper left corner of iTunes, which should say Music and select Toni. The new ringtone appears on this page, indicating that of the file has been successfully modified. Connect your iPhone to your computer using the USB cable. Select your iPhone when it appears at the top right of the iTunes window. Click the Tones tab, and then click the Sync Tones button. Click Apply, and then click Sync when syncing is complete, close iTunes, and disconnect the USB cable. Start Settings from the iPhone home screen. Scroll down and tap Sounds. Scroll down again and tap Ringtone. You can now select your custom ringtone from the list of available options. A ringtone be any kind of audio, from parts of songs to their own voice recordings. Open it with the editing program and use the tools to select the beginning and end of the audio part you want for a ringtone. Ringtones are typically 30 seconds long or less and include the most eye-catching section of the audio. Save the clip as MP3 for use on most mobile phones. If you choose to use an online editing program, upload the file to the provider's website and follow the instructions to create the clip. There are many locations for selling digital products online. Some of the websites that offer audio editing programs also provide shops or markets on the site where you can sell your work. Keep in mind that many charge a fee for the service, which could be calculated per listing or per sale. If you prefer to keep all profits, consider selling ringtones through your website or blog by installing an ecommerce shopping cart on your page. Content for Apple products is more regulated and only available through iTunes. If you want to sell iPhone ringtones on iTunes, you need to have a catalog of at least 20 albums or sell through one of the company's Apple-aggregator approved. Aggregators format and deliver content on iTunes for a fee. They include distribution sites such as Snipsell, Catapult and Tunecore. Many ringtones are songs by popular artists. However, keep in mind that it is illegal to use licensed work without the owner's permission. If you want to perform ringtones from a popular song, movie track, or other copyrighted product, contact the creator or license company. Note that you will have to pay a royalty fee on each ringtone you sell containing the work. A ringtone is the sound your phone makes when there's an incoming call. Ringtones come in many different sounds. Even if the phone comes with some you can download additional ringtones directly from your mobile service provider or from one of the many websites that offer ringtones [source: Beck]. This requires your phone to be connected to the Internet over a wireless connection. There are several types of ringtones, including: Musical Tones Your phone will play of a melody every time it rings. Voice tones You hear a recorded voice whenever there is an incoming call. Sound tones You hear sound effects when your phone rings [source: ATT]. Here's how to get ringtones offered by two of the most popular mobile phone providers.
